

# AUA and AUA Foundation Promote Prostate Cancer Awareness on Capitol Hill

In September, the American Urological Association (AUA) and the AUA Foundation worked on Capitol Hill and in the Washington, DC area to promote awareness of the AUA's new recommendations on prostate cancer testing. Most notably, Mike Haynes, an AUA Foundation spokesperson for prostate cancer awareness and Pro Football Hall of Famer, was joined by eight members of Congress at a Meet & Greet event on Capitol Hill on September 24. Attendees included Rep. Paul Broun, MD (R-GA), Sen. Saxby Chambliss (R-GA),
